HOUSE RULES

- Visitors who are drunk or under the influence of drugs will be denied entry;
- Alcohol will only be served to visitors aged 18 or over. Visitors who pass alcohol to persons under 18, and persons under 18 who consume alcohol, will be denied entry;
- Visitors acknowledge that they may be recorded on camera;
- In the interest of safety, visitors must follow the instructions of staff;
- The national non-smoking regulations apply in this establishment. Smoking and the use of e-cigarettes are only permitted in designated areas of the terrace;
- Weapons, knives, and hard drugs are prohibited. If visitors are found in possession of these items, the police will always be notified;
- For security reasons, visitors may be subject to pat-down searches and bags may be inspected;
- Visitors may be exposed to sound levels exceeding 80 dBA. Hearing protection is the visitor's own responsibility;
- If a visitor observes or experiences nuisance or intimidation from another visitor in any form, they are requested to immediately report this to staff such as security, bar staff, or glass collectors, so that appropriate action can be taken without delay.

IT IS NOT PERMITTED TO

- Trade in soft or hard drugs. The use of soft or hard drugs is also not permitted;
- Bring outside food or beverages, stickers, or markers inside;
- Take glassware outside;
- Engage in racism, sexism, homophobia, transphobia, xenophobia, fatphobia, albinism-related discrimination, age discrimination, or behave in any other way that is disruptive, aggressive, discriminatory, or intimidating toward fellow visitors or staff.
